If you have patience, like problem-solving, and would like to make a difference to someone who has special needs this could be the role for you. In this volunteering role you could make a difference just by allowing your client to talk, help them to solve their day-to-day problems, gain their trust, and help with their self esteem.

No experience necessary, but this role requires someone who can commit to the client.
